The journal will publish original research papers, reviews, short communications, and case reports to encourage critical engagement with these topics, and to promote scientific responsibility and an international and interdisciplinary exchange of views and ideas.

There is no submission fee, no article processing fee, and no publication fee. Submissions are subject to double-blind peer review. The journal is published three times a year, available both online and in print, and widely indexed and disseminated internationally, offering authors high visibility for their work and access to a broad readership. The Bangladesh Journal of Bioethics is the official journal of the Bangladesh Bioethics Society (www.bioethics.org.bd), the only academic organization in Bangladesh exclusively dedicated to the promotion of the study of bioethics.
